

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B6021 KIRKBY FOLLY ROAD AND LOWMOOR ROAD, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) (RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER 2023 (4288)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton in Ashfield in the District of Ashfield in the County of Nottinghamshire.

1. The lengths of road specified in the Schedule of this Order shall be a Restricted Road (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

B6021 KIRKBY FOLLY ROAD, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD

• From a point 46 metres south-west of its junction with B6022 Station Road in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Maun View Gardens

B6021 LOWMOOR ROAD, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD

• From its junction with Maun View Gardens a south-westerly direction to a point 12 metres south-west of its junction with Maun View Gardens
