

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WOODSTOCK STREET, HUCKNALL)**  
**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**  
**(4290)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Hucknall in the District of Ashfield: -

1. Proposed **prohibition of Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

**WOODSTOCK STREET, HUCKNALL** (the south-east side)

- From a point 27 metres south-west of its junction with Portland Road in a south-westerly direction for 7 metres

2. Proposed **30-minute Limited Waiting Parking Bays** along the following lengths of road: -

**WOODSTOCK STREET, HUCKNALL** (the south-east side)

- From a point 21 metres south-west of its junction with Portland Road in a south-westerly direction for 6 metres

3. Proposed **Residents Only Parking Bays** along the following lengths of road: -

**WOODSTOCK STREET, HUCKNALL** (the south-east side)

- From a point 27 metres north-east of its junction with Beardall Street in a north-easterly direction for 91 metres.
