

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FACKLEY ROAD, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (4291)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield.

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

FACKLEY ROAD, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (the south-east side)

- From its junction with the B6014 Fackley Road and High Street Roundabout in a north-easterly direction for 71 metres
- 2. Other restrictions: Bus Stop Clearway No Stopping At Any Time, except Buses

FACKLEY ROAD, SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD (the south-east side)

• From a point 25 metres north-east of its junction with the Fackley Road and High Street Roundabout in a north-easterly for 19 metres
