## **THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CARLINGFORD ROAD AND LINBY WALK, HUCKNALL) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024 (4298)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Hucknall in the District of Ashfield: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from **Waiting At Any Time** along the following lengths of road: -

**CARLINGFORD ROAD, HUCKNALL** (the east side)

- From its junction with Carlingford Road (east to west section) in a southerly direction for 6 metres

**CARLINGFORD ROAD, HUCKNALL** (the north side)

- From a point 8 metres south of its junction with Linby Walk in an easterly direction up to and including its eastern extremity

**CARLINGFORD ROAD, HUCKNALL** (the south side)

- From a point 26 metres south-east of its junction with St Mary's Way in an easterly direction up to and including its eastern extremity

**LINBY WALK, HUCKNALL** (the north-west side)

- From its junction with Carlingford Road in a north-easterly direction for 104 metres

**LINBY WALK, HUCKNALL** (the south-east side)

- From its junction with Carlingford Road in a north-easterly direction for 75 metres
