

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BARTON LANE, ATTENBOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (5336)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Attenborough in the Borough of Broxtowe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

BARTON LANE, ATTENBOROUGH (the north-east side)

- From a point 96 metres north-west of the mid-point of the railway in a north-westerly direction for 30 metres
- From a point 144 metres north-west of the mid-point of the railway in a north-westerly direction for 16 metres
- From a point 184 metres north-west of the mid-point of the railway in a north-westerly direction for 90 metres
- From a point 328 metres north-west of the mid-point of the railway in a north-westerly direction for 9 metres

BARTON LANE, ATTENBOROUGH (the south-west side)

 From a point 94 metres north-west of the mid-point of the railway in a north-westerly direction for 243 metres
