

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DENISON STREET AND WOLLATON ROAD, BEESTON) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025 (5343)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Beeston in the Borough of Broxtowe:

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

DENISON STREET, BEESTON (the north-west side)

• From its junction with Wollaton Road in a south-westerly direction for 22 metres

DENISON STREET, BEESTON (the south-east side)

From its junction with Wollaton Road in a south-westerly direction for 10 metres

WOLLATON ROAD, BEESTON (the south-west side)

• From a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Denison Street in a north westerly direction to a point 10 metres north-west of that junction
