

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Beaumaris Drive, Burton Road and New entrance to Carlton le Willows Academy, Gedling) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2024 (7247)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads in the Borough of Gedling:-

- 1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting At Any Time along: -
- (i) <u>BEAUMARIS DRIVE (GEDLING) (Both sides)</u> from its junction with Burton Road in a south-easterly direction for 17 metres.
- (ii) <u>BURTON ROAD (GEDLING) (the north-west side)</u> from a point opposite a point 42 metres south-west of its junction with Beaumaris Drive in a north-easterly direction to a point opposite a point 58 metres north-east of that junction.
- (iii) <u>BURTON ROAD (GEDLING) (the south-east side)</u> from a point 42 metres south-west of its junction with Beaumaris Drive in a north-easterly direction to a point 58 metres north-east of that junction.
- (iv) NEW ENTRANCE TO CARLTON LE WILLOWS ACAMEDY (GEDLING) (Both sides) from its junction with Burton Road in a north-westerly direction for 13 metres.
- 2. Other Restrictions Bus Stop Clearway No Stopping At Any Time, except Buses
- (i) BURTON ROAD GEDLING (the north-west side)

Bus Stop GE0787 – from a point opposite a point 42 metres south-west of its junction with Beaumaris Drive in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres.

THIS ORDER SHALL COME INTO FORCE ON 29TH JANUARY 2024

The restrictions have been introduced as part of the scheme to provide a new access into the Carlton le Willows Academy. The new double yellow lines will help to ensure that the junction of Burton Road/Beaumaris Drive and the junction with the New Academy Entrance/Burton Road are kept clear of parked vehicles to allow an unobstructed crossing point for pedestrians and give better visibility for vehicles turning in or out. The bus stop clearway is to ensure that the bus can always stop at the kerb line to drop off and pick up passengers.
