

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CURZON STREET AREA, NETHERFIELD – VARIOUS LOCATIONS) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (7252)

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Via East Midlands Ltd, is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services in Nottinghamshire. Concerns have been raised about obstructive parking at these junctions of Curzon Street, Dunstan Street, Asper Street and Cross Street, Netherfield. This reduces visibility and access for drivers and pedestrians using these junctions.

To help alleviate these problems 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) have been introduced around the junctions as shown on drawing number H/JA/3887/01.

Since the original advert, the double yellow lines that were originally proposed on the north-east side of the junction between Cross Street and Curzon Street have been reduced from 10 metres to 5 metres. This is to maintain access for a disabled resident who has a bay outside their house.
