**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Bingham in the Borough of Rushcliffe in the County of Nottinghamshire.

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on that length of road specified in the Schedule of this Order.

**BANKS CRESCENT, BINGHAM**

- From its junction with The Banks in a northerly direction along its entire length

**FISHER LANE, BINGHAM**

- From its junction with The Banks in a northerly direction along its entire length

**MELWYN DRIVE, BINGHAM**

- From its junction with The Banks in a northerly direction along its entire length

**THE BANKS, BINGHAM**

- From its junction with Tithby Road in an easterly direction to its junction with Grantham Road
