

The Nottinghamshire County Council (New Vale Road, Rectory Road and Vale Road, Colwick) - (Prohibition of Waiting)(7192) and (Vale Road, Colwick) (Prohibition of Driving – Bus Lane) (7193)Traffic Regulation Orders 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Colwick in the Borough of Gedling:-

1. **to prohibit waiting at any time on the following roads,**
 - (i) **Balmoral Road (the north-west side)** - from the junction with Lockerbie Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 13 metres.
 - (ii) **Balmoral Road (the south-east side)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 7 metres.
 - (iii) **Chaworth Road (the north-west side)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
 - (iv) **Furzebrook Road (both sides)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
 - (v) **Lawrence Avenue (both sides)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
 - (vi) **Lockerbie Street (both sides)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
 - (v) **New Vale Road (both sides)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
 - (vi) **Sands Close (both sides)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.
 - (vii) **Vale Road (the north-east side)** - from a point 35 metres north of its junction with Mile End Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Balmoral Road.
 - (viii) from its junction with Chaworth Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.
 - (ix) **Vale Road (the north-west side)** - from a point 35 metres north of its junction with Mile End Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Balmoral Road.
 - (x) **Vale Road (the south-east side)** - from a point 3 metres south-west of a point opposite the south-western kerb line of Lockerbie Street in a north-easterly and then a south-easterly direction for a distance of 21 metres.
 - (xi) **Vale Road (the south-west side)** - from its junction with Road No.1 in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 32 metres.
 - (xii) **Verona Avenue (both sides)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
2. **to prohibit waiting and loading on Monday – Friday between 7.30 & 9.30am on the following roads,**
 - (i) **Rectory Road (Both sides)** - from its junction with Vale Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres
 - (ii) **Vale Road (the south-east side)** - from a point 48 metres north-east of its junction with Mile End Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 39 metres north-east of the junction with Rectory Road.
3. **Introduce a lane for buses and cycles only on Monday – Friday between 7.30 & 9.30am**
 - (i) **Vale Road (the south-east side)** - From a point 16 metres north-east of its junction with Rectory Road in a south-westerly direction to a point 58 metres south-west of the same junction.

The above restrictions are being introduced as part of the scheme to improve the bus routes in the Colwick/Gedling area as a result of the new housing developments planned to be built in the local area.
