

PROVISION OF TOUCAN CROSSING ON VICTORIA ROAD, NETHERFIELD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a toucan crossing on Victoria Road, Netherfield in the Borough of Gedling, in between the three junctions of Colwick Loop Road, Nether Pasture and Great Northern Way.

1. The proposals will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

VICTORIA ROAD, NETHERFIELD (the north side)

- From a point 14 metres north-west of it's junction with Great Northern Way in a south-easterly direction for 53 metres.

VICTORIA ROAD, NETHERFIELD (the south side)

- From a point 10 metres north-west of it's junction with Nether Pasture in a south-easterly direction for 53 metres.

The proposed Toucan Crossing would improve pedestrian and cyclist accessibility when crossing over Victoria Road. Further details can be found by visiting the County Council's website (<https://consult.nottinghamshire.gov.uk>)
