

PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING ON VILLAGE STREET, EDWALTON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a zebra crossing on Village Street, Edwalton in the Borough of Rushcliffe, west of Village Close.

1. The proposals will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

VILLAGE STREET, EDWALTON (the north side)

• From a point opposite a point 36 metres west of its junction with Village Close in an easterly direction for 41m.

VILLAGE STREET, EDWALTON (the south side)

• From a point 5 metres east of its junction with Village Close in a westerly direction for 45m.

The crossing is being installed to improve the safety of pedestrians crossing the road to access the shops and for school children on their way to and from Edwalton Primary School. Further details can be found by visiting the County Council's website (<u>https://consult.nottinghamshire.gov.uk</u>)
