

**NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
PROVISION OF TOUCAN CROSSING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a “Toucan” pedestrian & cycle crossing on Watnall Road, Hucknall in the District of Ashfield approximately 20 metres east of its junction with the A611 Hucknall Bypass.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area will be:

Watnall Road

From a point at the eastbound exit from the roundabout junction with the A611 for a distance of approximately 45m in a northeast direction.

The Toucan crossing will provide a safe crossing facility across Watnall Road for pedestrians and cyclists.
