

<u>The Nottinghamshire County Council (Whinney Lane, Ollerton) (30 M.P.H. Speed Limit)</u> <u>Restricted Road and (60 M.P.H.) Derestricted Road Order 2019 (3302)</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Ollerton in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

1. Length of Whinney Lane shall become a restricted road (30mph speed limit)

from a point 60 metres north of its junction with Petersmiths Drive in a northerly direction to a point 43 metres north of the centre point of its junction with Riverdale Road.

2. Length of Whinney Lane shall be a derestricted road (National Speed Limit of 60mph)

from a point 43 metres north of the centre point of its junction with Riverdale Road in a northerly direction to a point 81 metres south of the centre with its junction with Brake Lane.

The 30 mph speed limit is to be extended northwards by approximately 170 metres. The new speed limit would include the new access road (Riverdale Road) into the new housing development. The speed limit would help to ensure that vehicles entering the built up area are travelling at a lower speed. The road north of the new speed limit has a system of street lights and in order to keep the road at the National Speed Limit of 60mph it is proposed to introduce a derestriction speed limit order to this length of road.
