**WILLOW LANE AND WILLOW CRESCENT, GEDLING –
PROPOSED PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME (DOUBLE YELLOW LINES)
– PUBLIC CONSULTATION – TRO 7232**

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) to Willow Lane and Willow Crescent, Gedling. The proposed restrictions would remove parked vehicles from the bend between the old railway bridge and Willow Crescent and at the junction of Willow Lane and Willow Crescent. The removal of parking will help ensure that when vehicles are heading in a north-easterly direction they do not encounter traffic on their side of the road. The restrictions at the junction will improve visibility for vehicles turning into or out of Willow Crescent and keep the junction clear for pedestrians crossing the road. The proposals are intended to improve conditions for pupils attending the Willow Farm Primary School.

Before proceeding further, I wish to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter (address at bottom of letter) or email, by **26th April 2021**.
