

ACTIVE TRAVEL FUND REGATTA WAY, WEST BRIDGFORD

The Active Travel Fund (ATF) has been created by the Department for Transport (DfT) as part of its Covid-19 response, for local authorities to bid for funding for active travel schemes. The purpose of the fund is to implement interventions that make cycling and walking safer during the pandemic with a view to embedding walking and cycling as part of long-term commuting habits. Schemes funded by the ATF will support social distancing in the short-term and offer significant long-term health, environmental and congestion benefits.

Nottinghamshire County Council has been successful in securing funding for several potential cycle and footway improvement schemes across the county and to implement behavioural change measures within these local areas. The proposed scheme in West Bridgford will upgrade the existing shared use footway/cycleway facility on Regatta Way, between A6011 Radcliffe Road and Adbolton Lane, to provide a fully segregated two-way cycleway adjacent to the footway. The proposed scheme will improve safety for cyclists and pedestrians using this route, which links existing employment sites and residential conurbations to recreational facilities at Holme Pierrepoint and the wider cycle network.
